AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION CLARIFYING THE APPLICATION OF THE SHIFT PREMIUM STIPEND PAID TO PART-TIME MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR 2019

WHEREAS, in December of 2018, the rates of pay were established for part-time members of the Fire Department for the 2019 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to clarify that the shift premium stipend applies to paramedics and to all shifts for which Department members are stationed at Northfield Park, regardless of the day of the week and time worked.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Northfield, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That, effective January 1, 2019, part-time members of the Fire Department shall be paid at the rates set forth below.

Fire Chief	\$29,276 per annum
Captain/Paramedic	\$17.35/hr.
Captain/EMT	\$16.54/hr.
Lieutenant/Paramedic	\$16.94/hr.
Lieutenant/EMT	\$16.13/hr.
Firefighter/Paramedic	\$16.52/hr.
Firefighter/EMT	\$15.74/hr.

SECTION 2. In addition to the above wage rates, all part-time firefighters and paramedics shall receive a \$2.00 per hour shift premium stipend for all hours worked for the Village from 6:00 p.m. on Friday through 6:00 a.m. on Monday and for all shifts for which they are stationed at Northfield Park, regardless of the day of the week and time worked.

SECTION 3. That all formal actions of this Council and any actions of its committees that resulted in those formal actions relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with law.


