REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

May 22, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Nehez at 7:30 p.m., and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Nehez.

ROLL CALL was read by Brad Bryan. The following officials were present: Councilpersons Nick Magistrelli, Keith Czerr, Alan Hipps, Renell Noack, and Gary Vojtush. Also present for the meeting were Police Chief John Zoligus and Fire Captain Joe Zemek.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the Minutes from the May 8, 2019 Council Meeting was made by Ms. Noack and seconded by Mr. Magistrelli. All were in favor of approval of the Minutes of May 8, 2019; none were opposed. The Minutes were approved.

PRESENTATION OF PROCLAMATIONS:

Mayor Nehez turned the floor over to Northfield Village Police Department School Resource Officer Brian Zambach. Officer Zambach recognized four students from Lee Eaton School. Officer Zambach called Abby Pohlmeier, Natalie Barnes, Charlotte Naymik, and Kendall Haynes and awarded them Proclamations for their assistance in taking immediate action when a staff member at Lee Eaton School fell ill on May 1, 2019.
