Service Department :

Rumpke Trash Collection- Please make sure containers or bags are under fifty pounds. Please follow the FDA guidelines below or disposing of sharps so no one gets potentially stuck, cut or punctured.

If an FDA-cleared container is not available, place used sharps in a strong, plastic container, like a laundry detergent or bleach bottle. The container should be leak-resistant, remain upright during use, and have a tight-fitting, puncture-resistant lid. Please label SHARPS DO NOT RECYCLE, duct tape the lid and dispose of container.

May Spring Cleanup- There will be five dumpsters for residents to use

located at the following locations:
