I, the undersigned, state that:

I, and all other occupants residing at the above listed address, are ***65 years of age or older and/or physically disabled***. (If disabled, doctor's note with specific medical condition listed must accompany application).

I am the owner or a resident of the single-family dwelling listed above.

The above listed dwelling has a solid driveway with no gravel or grass strips down the center.

I hereby release the Village of Northfield, its servants, agents and employees, from any and all liability arising from the removal of snow from the driveway at the residence listed above.

***Failure to comply with the above conditions shall result in immediate and permanent removal from the snowplowing program.**

I understand that driveways will be plowed only after the Mayor has determined snowfall of **4 or more inches**, and the Village streets have first been plowed.

I understand that the Village will plow my driveway **only once within a 24-hour period**.

I understand that parked vehicles and/or driveway-side awnings may prevent the complete plowing of my driveway.

I understand that I am to notify the Village of any extended periods of time (more than 1 week) when I will not be at the residence, or of any new persons added to the household during the snow removal service period.

SENIOR SNOW REMOVAL APPLICATION

It's that time of year again, and all senior/disabled Northfield residents who have not used the Village's Senior Snowplowing service in the past are urged to sign up early for the 2010-2011 season at the Town Hall. We are happy to report that snowplowing will be done *free of charge* again this year.

IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR ALL RESIDENTS WHO QUALIFY FOR THIS SERVICE TO FILL OUT A NEW APPLICATION FOR 2011-2012 SENIOR SNOW PLOWING REMOVAL NO MATTER IF YOU HAVE RECEIVED THIS SERVICE IN THE PAST OR NOT.

Applications can be filled out at the Village Hall at 10455 Northfield Rd or can be downloaded from the Village website at www.northfieldvillage-oh.gov on the service/building dept. page. and brought into the Village Hall. No applications will be done over the phone.

APPLICANTS MUST:

- 1.) Be at least **65 years of age**; furnish proof of age (copy of driver's license, etc.).
- 2.) Not reside with an able-bodied individual capable of removing snow.
- 3.) Release the Village, its servants, agents, and employees from, any liability arising out of snow removal on the registrant's property.
- 4.) ***If not at least 65 years of age, be physically disabled, regardless of age.*** These individuals must:
 - a.) Submit a doctor's certification stating the specific medical condition and that activity such as snow shoveling would be adverse to his/her health.
 - b.) Not reside with an able-bodied individual capable of removing snow.
 - c.) Release the Village, its servants, agents, and employees from any liability arising out of snow removal on the registrant's property.

Snow Plowing - Mailbox Policies and Procedures

As Winter approaches, it is the responsibility of each resident to ensure that their mailbox is sturdy enough to withstand snow and slush being plowed off of the road by Village trucks. the Service Department asks residents to examine their mailbox and post to determine if it is stable and sturdy enough to withstand the snow and slush being plowed off of the road by Village trucks.

The Village is not responsible for damaged mailboxes that are the result of plowed snow and slush, boxes that are too closed to the street as defined by postal regulations, or boxes that were not sturdy to begin with. The Village has the right to judge whether or not mailbox damage was caused by a snow plow truck or not.
